3. Read John 10:27. As you do mark every reference to Lord[†] with a cross and circle every reference to sheep. Then list below what you learn.

Reflect: Who is it that hear's Jesus voice?
How do they respond when they hear?

4. Read John 14:23. As you do mark every reference to Lord[†] with a cross and circle every reference to anyone as before. Then list below what you learn.

Reflect: What are those who love Him to do?
What does the Father do?
